#### Map

*Mapping available provision and identifying gaps in training*

We have been mapping the EDI provision in the local area, and identifying where additional provision is needed



#### Simplify

*Make the skills system easier to access for employers in the local area*

Hosting codesign events to give employers and further education the opportunity to speak directly, translate business needs to providers and help businesses have a better understanding of the skills system



#### Amplify

*Highlight the existing work that is being done by the local area's education and independent training providers*

The LSIP team are attending events across the local area to talk to employers about what support and provision is available



#### Support

*Work collaboratively with partners, providers and employers in the local area to achieve their goals and meet their skills needs*
