The *Green Skills Sprint* we are conducting will create a clear definition of green skills for the local area and will map provision, helping to identify demand and training gaps

Aligned with LSIP priorities, SGS College launched a *Retrofit Bootcamp* which provided short, modular training – the preferred method of delivery reported to us by employers

Business West launched in-person and online *Skills Clinics* with Skills Advisors. These support businesses to identify their skills gaps, access ongoing support and find relevant training opportunities with partners throughout their skills journey

Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) have published a report identifying existing *training and funding* available that aligns with the LSIP priorities and findings. This is being promoted through their network and Business West signposting activities
