

I AM NOT A LEVY PAYER

If you've an annual payroll of **less than £3m**, you won't pay into the levy, though you need to be aware of the changes to apprenticeship funding



Small businesses can benefit from a **100% contribution** from the government for taking on apprentices who are 16-18 years-old, 19-24 year-old care leavers, or those with an Education, Health and Care Plan

The cost of apprenticeship training is categorised into **30** funding bands ranging from **£1,500 to £27,000**



95% of training costs are funded by government.

Businesses only need to contribute 5%



Apprenticeships can be used to pay for the training of **either new recruits or existing staff**

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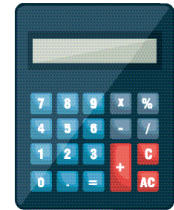
Levy is for employers who've an annual payroll in excess of **£3m**

Your apprenticeship levy can be used to pay for the training of either **new recruits or existing staff**

0.5% of your payroll bill will be transferred to your levy account
(minus your £15,000 government allowance)

If you use all of your levy allowance, you can **top up your digital account**. The government will pay 95% and you co-invest 5%

Levy paying employers can transfer up to **25% of their unspent levy fund** to support apprenticeships in other businesses



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
